COVID Marshal online training

From Friday 21 August, businesses and activities across a number of sectors must have a COVID Marshal. This includes those that involve any of the following:

- hospitality
- gyms and fitness centre
- indoor and outdoor sports clubs
- swimming pools available for public use
- social and community clubs
- religious or faith-based ceremonies
- supermarkets and hardware stores
- distribution centres
- businesses or activities that are required to have a COVID Management Plan.

Active surveillance in medi-hotel staff

SA Health will commence testing of asymptomatic workers in medi-hotels. Noting that we continue to have active cases of COVID-19 from overseas passengers within medi-hotels, from today hotel and security staff will be tested similarly to the asymptomatic testing already underway in health and aged care workers, and truck drivers. This precautionary testing is another step in protecting the community.

There is no requirement for workers undergoing asymptomatic testing to self-isolate while waiting for their result, which is consistent with national guidance for asymptomatic testing.

New COVID-19 case

A woman in her 30s who returned from overseas on a repatriation flight has returned a positive test result. She has been quarantining in a medi-hotel since her arrival and is a close contact of yesterday's confirmed case.
