COVID-19 UPDATE 79: FRIDAY 14 AUGUST 2020

Update to Public Activities Direction

The new [Direction](#) includes changes to restrictions on gatherings at residential premises. Up to 10 visitors will now be allowed at a residential premises. This is in addition to those who normally live there, but is capped to a total of 20 people.

Gatherings at a private place (like a farm or hall) are now restricted to no more than 100 people, regardless of whether they are indoor or outdoor. The one person per two square metres density requirement still applies.

As of the 21 August 2020, COVID Marshals will be required across a number of sectors to ensure businesses and organisations are fulfilling their COVID Safe obligations and recommendations. COVID Marshal online training will be available next week.
