COVID-19 health alert

Anyone who visited the Intensive English Language Institute (Flinders University Sturt Campus) any time between 13 November until 28 November 2020 must immediately self-quarantine for 14 days. This includes people who live with them.

People who visited this location must get a COVID-19 test on day 1 and day 12 of quarantine. Some people may be asked to have additional tests.

The [Parafield Cluster Isolation Direction](#) was updated to include the Intensive English Language Institute.

Anyone who visited the below locations during the listed date and time should seek testing immediately, even if they do not have any symptoms, and isolate until they get their results.

- Flinders University Sturt Campus, Bedford Park – 13 November to 28 November
- Big W Brickworks, Torrensville – Sunday 22 November 12.15pm to 12.50pm
- Foodland Norwood, Norwood – Sunday 22 November 1.20pm to 2.00pm
- Kmart, Kurralta Park – Sunday 22 November 2.45pm to 3.10pm

Anyone who visited the below locations during the listed date and times should monitor for symptoms and get tested immediately if symptoms appear.

- On The Run, Hilton – Sunday 22 November 12.05pm to 12.15pm
- Anaconda, Mile End – Sunday November 12.55pm to 1.05pm
- Guzman y Gomez, Glandore – Sunday 22 November 2.45pm to 2.50pm

- Glenelg Boost Juice, Glenelg – Sunday 22 November 3.20pm to 3.30pm
