## **COVID-19 UPDATE 138: SUNDAY 15 NOVEMBER 2020**

### **COVID-19 health alert**

SA Health is in the process of contacting people who were in the Emergency Department at Lyell McEwin Hospital between 5.30pm Friday 13 November and 4.00am Saturday 14 November who may have been in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19. However, anyone who was at the Emergency Department during these hours and has not been contacted by SA Health should self-quarantine immediately and contact SA COVID-19 Information Line on 1800 253 787.

Anyone who visited Parafield Plaza Supermarket on Thursday 12 November between 10:30am and 11:30am does not need to self-quarantine but should monitor for symptoms and get tested immediately if symptoms appear.

### **New COVID-19 cases**

There have been four new cases of COVID-19 today. Of the cases, one is a man in his 30s who has recently returned from overseas and has been in a medi-hotel since his arrival.

Another case is a woman in her 80s who tested positive at the Lyell McEwin Hospital emergency department on Saturday 14 November. The woman is in hospital in a stable condition.

While contact tracing is still underway, two family members of the woman in her 80s have also tested positive.

Of these two cases—a woman in her 50s and a man in his 60s, who are both quarantining in a medi-hotel—one works in a medi-hotel. SA Health is working to confirm this is the cause of initial transmission.

### **Parafield COVID-19 mobile testing clinic**

From tomorrow, a mobile COVID-19 testing clinic will be operating at the Corner of Lockheed Lane and Butler Avenue at Parafield Airport.

The site will operate from 8.00am to 6.00pm, 7 days a week. All ages and walk-ins are welcome and no booking or referral is required.
