## Book your COVID-19 vaccine online now

All South Australians aged 12 years and over are eligible to book an appointment for COVID-19 vaccines. Bookings are available for:

- Pfizer (12+ years),
- Moderna (12+ years), and
- AstraZeneca (18+ years).

## **COVID-19 Moderna vaccine**

The Moderna COVID-19 vaccine is now available in SA. The vaccine has been approved for use in Australia by the Therapeutic Goods Administration and is available at participating pharmacies for anyone aged 12 and over. 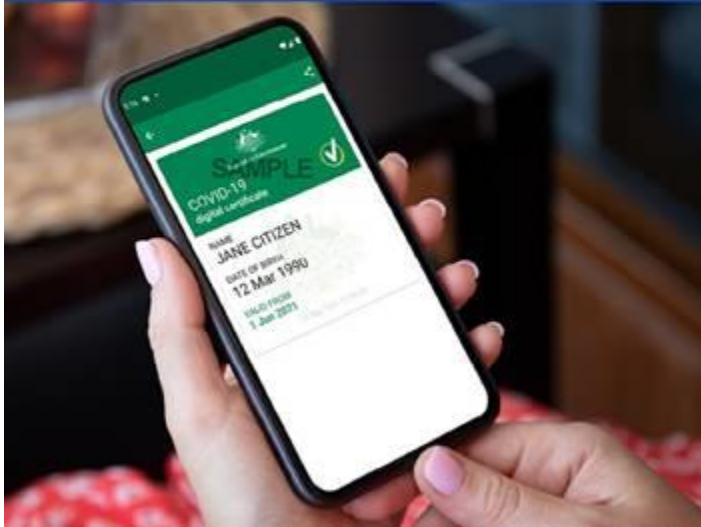
## **COVID-19 Digital Certificate**

Get your immunisation history statement or COVID-19 digital certificate to show proof of your vaccinations using:

- [Medicare online account through myGov](#), or
- [Express Plus Medicare mobile app](#).
