## COVID-19 update 350

24 September 2021

### Cross Border Travel Direction update

From 12.01am 25 September 2021, there will be no testing or quarantine requirements for people entering South Australia from the City of Brisbane and Logan City LGAs.

Travellers who entered South Australia before 12.01am 25 September and have been in the City of Brisbane LGA or Logan City LGA in the last 14 days, must:

- get a COVID-19 test as soon as possible and quarantine until they receive a negative result.
- get tested again on day 5 and day 13 after arrival.
- not attend a [COVID Management Plan event](#) for 14 days after their arrival.
- not enter a high risk setting for 14 days after their arrival, unless they meet the requirements to be permitted (i.e. urgent medical care or other essential services).
