COVID-19 vaccine eligibility update

All South Australians aged 12 years and over are eligible to book an appointment for COVID-19 vaccines.



The Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine is now available for anyone 12 years and over in South Australia.

Appointments are in high demand, and more will be added as more vaccine becomes available. If you cannot find an appointment now, please try again later or look for an alternative vaccination clinic.

Priority access for year 11 and 12 school students

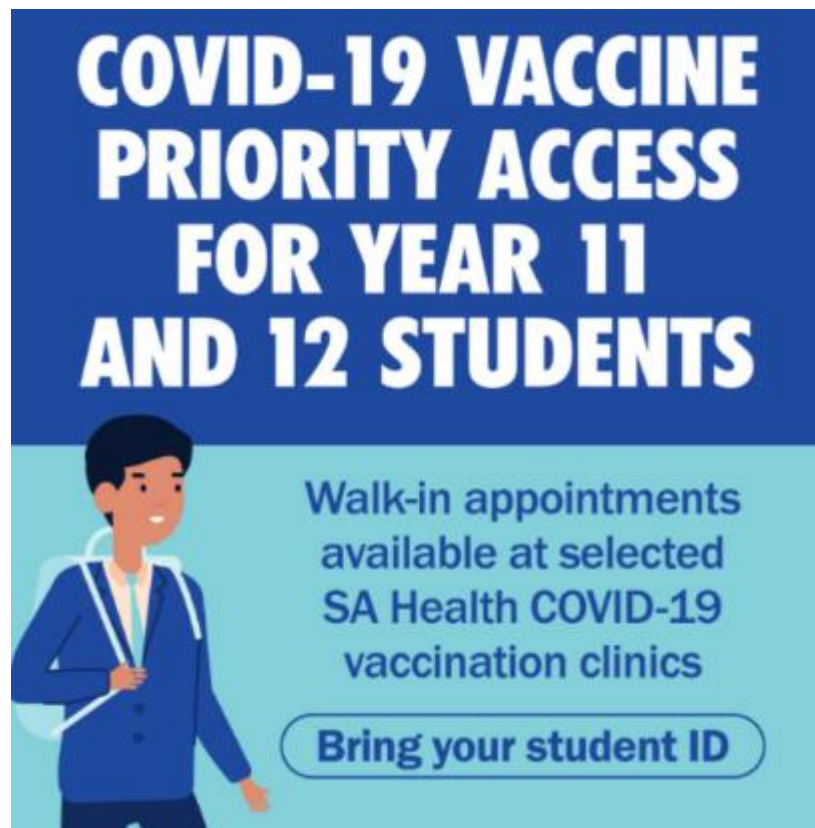
Year 11 and 12 students can get priority access for COVID-19 vaccination at SA Health COVID-19 vaccination clinics during September. This allows them to be fully vaccinated before they finish school.

Year 11 or 12 students can walk in at the following SA Health COVID-19 vaccination clinics without an appointment and show a student ID:

- Wayville (before 3.30pm)
- Elizabeth
- Enfield
- Noarlunga

- Port Augusta
- Whyalla
- Port Lincoln
- Victor Harbor (call before attending 0468 576 150)
- Mount Barker (call before attending 0468 576 150)
- Gawler (call before attending 0468 576 150)

COVID-19 restrictions

Restrictions in South Australia have changed. Private functions, including weddings and funerals, now have a limit of 150 guests if held at a licensed

premises.

Home gatherings are still only able to have 20 people in total (including the people who live there).

Please remember that if more than 50 people are present at a private activity, there are restrictions on dancing and singing. The activity also requires an approved contact tracing system, as well as a COVID Marshal (independent and not impaired by alcohol or drugs).
