We are pleased to announce that MCCSA in partnership with Terry White Cumberland Park Pharmacy is holding a special COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic at our Multicultural Hub on **Saturday 6 November 2021, 9am to 12noon**. I am reaching out to you as community leaders to share this amongst your members.

As you are aware, the Australian community pharmacy network is now participating in the national COVID-19 vaccine roll-out to deliver free, safe and effective COVID-19 vaccines to members of the public. Pharmacist vaccinators are registered pharmacists who have undertaken specific training in the COVID-19 vaccines, which is the same for all health care workers administering COVID-19 vaccines.

The **MCCSA Special COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic** will be offering the **AstraZeneca and Moderna COVID-19 vaccines** to those at an age that the vaccine is approved for or is provisionally approved for use by the Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA).

AstraZeneca vaccine

- 60 years old and over
- 18 to 59 years old, you can choose to have AstraZeneca after discussing with your health professional.

Moderna vaccine

- 12 years old and over
