## **SA exposure locations**

SA Health has identified exposure locations in South Australia associated with a positive case of COVID-19. Action is required by the community.

## **Activities Direction update**

The [Emergency Management \(Activities Associated No 14A\) \(COVID-19\) Direction 2021](#) was released and includes restrictions relating to the local government areas of Mount Gambier City, District Council of Grant and Wattle Range Council.

## **Cross Border Travel Direction update**

From 7.41 pm 3 October 2021, the Victorian cross border corridor has been reduced to 30km into Victoria and 40km into South Australia.

Cross border community members who live within the corridor who are travelling for a permitted purpose may enter SA, provided they have not travelled beyond 30km into Victoria and have been associating with people outside the Victorian cross border corridor in the last 14 days.

## **COVID-19 case update**

There were four cases reported over the weekend. The cases are a man in his 20s who is considered historical and acquired overseas, a woman in her 30s who recently returned to SA from Victoria, a woman in her 40s from Mount Gambier who spent time in Victoria and a truck

driver in his 30s who tested positive in SA but has since returned to Victoria.
