### SA exposure locations

SA Health has identified exposure locations in South Australia associated with a positive case of COVID-19. Action is required by the community.

### Activities Direction update

Effective 10.52am 8 October 2021, the [Emergency Management \(Activities Associated No 14A\) \(COVID-19\) Direction 2021](#) has been revoked.

The City of Mount Gambier, District Council of Grant, and Wattle Range Council are now subject to the same activities and gatherings restrictions that apply to the rest of South Australia.

### Cross Border Travel Direction update

From 4.53pm 8 October 2021, the Victorian cross border corridor is extended to 70 km either side of the border, excluding any part of the city of Portland.

Cross border community members who live within the corridor who are travelling for a permitted purpose may enter SA, provided they have not travelled outside the Victorian cross border corridor and have been associating with people outside the Victorian cross border corridor in the last 14 days.

From 12.01am 18 October 2021, cross border community members who are ordinarily resident in the Victorian cross border corridor must be able to produce evidence of having received at least one dose of a TGA approved COVID-19 vaccination, unless they have a medical certificate stating they are exempt.
