SA exposure locations

SA Health has identified exposure locations in South Australia associated with a positive case of COVID-19. Action is required by the community.

Tasmania exposure locations

A number of COVID-19 [exposure locations](#) have been identified in Tasmania associated with positive cases of COVID-19.

Anyone who visited any of the exposure locations in Tasmania should quarantine immediately, get a COVID-19 test and complete the online form to notify SA Health that they were at this location.

Border restriction update

Effective 4.00pm 15 October 2021, restrictions have eased with Queensland. Travellers who entered South Australia before 4.00pm today and have been in City of Brisbane, Moreton Bay Regional Council, City of Gold Coast and or Logan City Council in the last 14 days, must:

- get a COVID-19 test as soon as possible and quarantine until they receive a negative result.
- get tested again on day 5 and day 13 after arrival.
- not attend a [COVID Management Plan event](#) for 14 days after their arrival.
- not enter a high risk setting for 14 days after their arrival, unless they meet requirements to be permitted (i.e. urgent medical care or end of life visit).

COVID-19 vaccine update

Currently, the Australian Technical Advisory Group on Immunisation (ATAGI) recommend that people who are severely immunocompromised aged 12 and over have a third dose of a COVID-19 vaccine. This is to increase the level of immunity for severely immunocompromised people to as close as possible to the general population.

GPs are able to vaccinate eligible patients with a third dose of a COVID-19 vaccine. If eligible patients cannot access this at their GP, they can attend a SA Health vaccination clinic site or pharmacy with evidence of eligibility.
