SA COVID-19 Information Line

From 7 November, the SA COVID-19 Information Line will be closed.

If you have COVID-19 and need health support, call the National Coronavirus Helpline on 1800 020 080. Clinical staff are available 24 hours, 7 days a week.

For support in your language, call the National Coronavirus Helpline on 1800 020 080 and select option 8 for free interpreting assistance.

If you test positive using a rapid antigen test, report your result using the [online form](#) on the SA Health website.

If you can't use the online form or do not have internet access, someone else can report the result for you.

You can also report your result by calling the Communicable Disease Control Branch on 1300 232 272 9am to 4pm, Monday to Friday. If you test positive outside of these hours, report your result the next business day.

You can also call the Communicable Disease Control Branch for help to register for free rapid antigen tests.
