

Emergency Kit

Get an Emergency Kit together today! It may save your life in an emergency.

An Emergency Kit can help save precious time in an emergency situation. It provides items you might need if you lose power or need to leave your home in a hurry.

Items your emergency kit should have:

- Battery-powered radio with spare batteries
- Torch with spare batteries
- First aid kit
- Candles and waterproof matches
- Important papers including emergency contact numbers
- A copy of your home emergency plan
- Waterproof bag for valuables

Keep your emergency kit in a waterproof storage container.

When you decide to leave add these items:

- Mobile phone and charger
 - Prescriptions, medications, toiletries
 - Clothing and strong shoes
 - Non-perishable food and drinking water
 - Anything special you need for other family members
- If you have pets don't forget leads, food and bowls
