

Information in emergencies

Keep a battery powered or wind-up torch and radio ready in case the power fails during an emergency or your mobile phone is not working. Test the batteries regularly.

ABC is the official Emergency Broadcaster - local ABC radio stations broadcast the emergency warnings and alerts relevant to their area.

ABC Listen app allows you to listen to emergency broadcasts from any ABC Radio station around Australia. Download it at <https://www.abc.net.au>

Emergency Plus uses GPS functionality in smart phones to help triple zero (000) caller provide critical location details required to mobilize emergency services. Download it at www.emergencyplus.com.au

Addinsight alerts you to Hazards or delays on Adelaide's road network via your phone's loud speaker, hand free kit or car stereo. Download it at <https://addinsight.com/>

Alert SA displays bushfire alerts, warnings, updates, Fire Danger Ratings and Total Fire Bans. Users are able to create multiple Watch Zones, specifying areas of interest to them. Download it at <https://alert.sa.gov.au/>

BOM Weather – The app allows you to access localised hourly and 7 day forecasts, radar and warnings – wherever you are – from Australia's official weather source, the Bureau of Meteorology. Download it at www.bom.gov.au
